

RESOLUTION NO. 1981 - 152

AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR ARCHITECT-ENGINEER SERVICES WITH ADACHE-CIUNI-LYNN ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$91,500 (80% UMTA AND 20% LOCAL FUNDING)

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority selected Adache-Ciuni-Lynn Associates, Inc., as the architect-engineer for Engineering Inspection and Report Services, under Technical Studies Grant OH-09-0086, by Resolution No. 1981-108, adopted April 21, 1981; and

WHEREAS, the contract with Adache-Ciuni-Lynn Associates, Inc., which has been negotiated in conformance with Resolution No. 1981-108 provides for the expenditure of funds in the amount not to exceed \$91,500.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Adache-Ciuni-Lynn Associates, Inc., for Engineering Inspection and Report Services as will be required by Project 20 - CUT Bridge Study, of Technical Studies Grant OH-09-0086.

Section 2. That said contract shall be consistent with the proposal submitted February 11, 1981.

Section 3. That the contract shall provide for the expenditure of funds not to exceed \$18,300 of GCRTA funds and \$73,200 of UMTA funds.


Section 4. That the funds for these Engineering Inspection and Report Services shall be allocated on an 80% federal-20% local basis as part of Technical Studies Grant OH-09-0086 and shall be subject to the rules and regulations of UMTA.

Section 5. That the expenditure of not to exceed \$18,300 be and it is hereby authorized as the local matching share for these Engineering Inspection and Report Services.

Section 6. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Request for Proposal; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution No. 1978-252; insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 7. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
