AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$51,600 FOR EMPLOYEE INCENTIVE PROGRAMS DURING THE YEAR 1981 FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY

4.	SAFETY COMMITTEE PROGRAM	\$ 2,000.00
5.	RETIREES RECOGNITION NIGHT	\$ 2,500.00
6.	SUPERVISORY SKILLS AND MANAGEMENT DEVELOPMENT	\$ 3,600.00
7.	SAFETY PATCH PROGRAM	\$ 5,000.00

Section 2. That the expenditure of funds for each program shall be subject to review and approval by the General Manager and the Secretary-Treasurer.

Section 3. That this Resolution is effective simmediately upon its adoption.
