

RESOLUTION NO. 1981-186

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH TOKYU CAR CORPORATION FOR FURNISHING & DELIVERING SIXTY (60) HEAVY RAIL VEHICLES, INCLUDING SPARE PARTS.

(\$12,000,000.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0054)  
(\$41,509,800.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0062)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Tokyu Car Corporation, received on the 29th day of May, 1981 for the furnishing and delivering of sixty (60) heavy rail vehicles, and including spare parts, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total estimated expenditure of Fifty-three Million Five Hundred Nine Thousand Eight Hundred & 00/100 (\$53,509,800.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.


Section 2. That said contract shall be subject to UMTA concurrence, and waiver of test requirements at TTC shall be requested.

Section 3. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1978-252; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
