

RESOLUTION NO. 1981 - 210

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH TI-BERT SYSTEMS, INC FOR PROJECT 5, BID PACKAGE E, GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, BUILDINGS 2 and 3, CENTRAL RAIL MAINTENANCE FACILITY (Est. \$15,400,000.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0054 80% UMTA and 20% Local funding)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Ti-Bert Systems, Inc. received on June 16, 1981 for Project 5, Bid Pac E, General Construction - Buildings 2 and 3, Central Rail Maintenance Facility, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total estimated expenditure of Fifteen million, four hundred thousand & 00/100 (\$15,400,000.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1978-252; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
