

RESOLUTION NO. 1981-221

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH DEMSHAR BUILDERS
COMPANY, INC., FOR CONSTRUCTION OF PLATFORM
AND FENCE ENCLOSURE AT W.74th STREET
(Est. \$22,495.00 - Capital Improvement Fund
OH-03-0054 80% UMTA and 20% Local Funding)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional
Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the bid of Demshar Builders Company, Inc., received on
August 4, 1981, for construction of platform and fence enclosure at W.74th Street
at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total estimated expenditure of
Twenty-Two Thousand, Four Hundred Ninety-Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$22,495.00),
be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and
the General Manger of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80%
UMTA funds.


Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation
of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifi-
cation and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action plan adopted by the Board of
Trustees in Resolution No. 1978-252; bonding, insurance requirements, and all
applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately
upon its adoption.
