

RESOLUTION NO. 1981-289

A RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING CLEVELAND CLINIC FOR THEIR EFFORTS IN PROMOTING THE USE OF PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION AMONG THEIR EMPLOYEES AND FOR THEIR LEADERSHIP AND FORESIGHT IN PARTICIPATING IN THE RTA MONTHLY PASS PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, Energy Conservation has become a prime concern for all residents of Cuyahoga County and of the entire nation; as well; and

WHEREAS, the uncertainty of future costs and supplies of vital energy sources has caused a re-evaluation of lifestyles and modes; and
