

RESOLUTION NO. 1981- 296

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE VOGT AND CONANT COMPANY
FOR EAST 55th STREET BRIDGE REPAIRS
(Est. \$255,500 - General Fund)

WHEREAS, by virtue of the physical damage to the East 55th Street Bridge from age and decay, the Board of Trustees declared an emergency; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 1981-176, the Board authorized the Director of Construction Management and Engineering to select the best available contractor by an expedited process to perform the necessary repairs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the proposal of the Vogt and Conant Company received on October 7, 1981, for East 55th Street Bridge Repairs, at the prices set forth in said proposal, involving a total estimated expenditure of not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$255,500), be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible proposal, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said proposer for the furnishing of said work.

Section 2. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution No. 1978-252; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
