

RESOLUTION NO. 1981-339

AUTHORIZING THE TRANSMITTAL OF A REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR PROVIDING PROFESSIONAL ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE SERVICES FOR THE REMOVAL OF LIQUID POLYCHLORINATED BIPHENYLS (PCB) FROM THE GCRTA PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Regional Transit Authority has recognized a need to remove and dispose of polychlorinated bihpenyl (PCB) from the rapid transit substation transformer and replace it with DOW CORNING SILICONE #561 and disposal of PCB containing rail car components; and

WHEREAS, the removal of PCB would provide protection for employees and the community from hazards involved from exposure to the substance in the location in which it is used and where reserve supplies are stored;

WHEREAS, the Authority does not have personnel with the expertise and equipment necessary to retrofill a transformer and to dispose of the drained liquid PCB and the rail car components containing the same substance according to the Enviromental Protection Agency (EPA) Standards;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Department of Procurement and is hereby authorized and directed to transmit a request for proposals for providing services for the removal and disposal of the liquid PCB drained from the transformer, as well as, the reserve supply of the same liquid at the same location. Also, the disposal of the PCB filled rail car components from the rail shops.

Section 2. That this resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Trustees.
