

RESOLUTION NO. 1982-16

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH EARL IVES
EQUIPMENT COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF ONE (1)
ONE TON ASPHALT ROLLER.
(\$5,689.00 - Capital Improvement OH-03-0062)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Earl Ives Equipment Company, received
on the 11th day of December, 1981 for the furnishing of one (1) one-ton
asphalt roller, at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total expendi-
ture of not to exceed Five Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-nine & 00/100 (\$5,689.00)
Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible
bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter
into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure
of 80% UMTA fund.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obliga-
tion of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid
Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the
Board of Trustees in Resolution 1978-252; bonding, insurance requirements and
all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately
upon its adoption.
