

RESOLUTION NO. 1982-38

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH EARL IVES
EQUIPMENT COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF ONE (1)
ASPHALT DRAG BOX (\$9,275.00 - Capital Improvement
Fund OH-03-0062)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Earl Ives Equipment Company,
received on the 11th day of December, 1981 for the furnishing of one
(1) asphalt drag box, at the price set forth in said bid, involving a
total expenditure not to exceed Nine Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-five &
00/100 (\$9,275.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the
lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority
is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the
furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure
of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an
obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contract
to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action
Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1978-252; bonding,
insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual
obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately
upon its adoption.
