

RESOLUTION NO. 1982-59

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH QEI, INC.
FOR MATERIAL PACKAGE 56-U7, FURNISH AND DELIVER
SUPERVISORY CONTROL AND TELEMETERING EQUIPMENT
(\$223,622.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0054)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of QEI, Inc. received on November 23, 1981 for furnishing and delivering Supervisory Control and Telemetering Equipment, at prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of not to exceed Two hundred twenty-three thousand six hundred twenty-two & 00/100 (\$223,622.00) Dollars, to reflect an increase of \$1,350.00 for installation and start up assistance, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution No. 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective upon concurrence by UMTA.
