

RESOLUTION NO. 1982- 81

AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO AMEND THE CONTRACT WITH MADISON-MADISON-INTERNATIONAL/PULLMAN-SWINDELL TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL AE SERVICES FOR PROJECT 4, CENTRAL BUS MAINTENANCE FACILITY AT AN ESTIMATED ADDITIONAL COST OF NOT TO EXCEED \$188,464.03 (CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0054 80% UMTA and 20% Local Funding)

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees authorized the General Manager to enter into a contract with Madison-Madison-International/Pullman-Swindell for AE Services for Project 4, Central Bus Maintenance Facility by Resolution 1979-38, adopted February 6, 1979; and

WHEREAS, additional AE services are required and the term of the contract must be extended;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to amend the contract with Madison-Madison-International/Pullman-Swindell to provide for additional AE services and an extension of the term of the contract at an estimated additional cost of not to exceed \$188,464.03. (Capital Grant OH-03-0054).

Section 2. That said contract as amended shall provide for an estimated expenditure of EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY-TWO AND 19/100 (\$857,742.19) with 80% UMTA funding.

Section 3. That this resolution shall be effective upon concurrence by UMTA.
