A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH GMC TRUCK AND COACH DIVISION, GENERAL MOTORS CORPORATION, FOR FURNISHING AND DELIVERING SEVENTY-SEVEN (77) DIESEL TRANSIT COACHES, INCLUDING OPTIONS 2 AND 4 (\$4,921,723.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-05-0053) (\$5,879,864.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0075)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of GMC Truck and Coach Division, General Motors Corporation, received on the 31st day of March, 1982 for the furnishing and delivering of seventy-seven (77) diesel transit coaches, and including Options 2 and 4 at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of Ten Million Eight Hundred One Thousand Five Hundred Eighty Seven & 00/100 (\$10,801,587.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall be subject to UMTA concurrence.
