## RESOLUTION NO. 1982 - 114

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH F. BUDDIE CONTRACTING, INC. FOR PLATFORM EDGE REPAIRS AT WEST 117TH STREET RAPID STATION AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$58,307 (\$58,307.00 - General Fund)

WHEREAS, the severe winter has accelerated the deterioration of the station platform edges at the West 117th Street Rapid Station; and

WHEREAS, such deterioration constitutes a real and present emergency to the Authority because of the actual physical damage to the structure;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the accelerated deterioration of the platform edges at the West 117th Street Rapid Station constitutes a real and present danger to the Authority.

Section 2. That the proposal of F. Buddie Contracting, Inc. received on April 20, 1982, for platform edge repairs at West 117th Street Rapid Station, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of not to exceed Fifty-eight thousand three hundred seven and 00/100 (\$58,307.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution No. 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
