

RESOLUTION NO. 1982- 133

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH HOUGH
SUPPLY & SPECIALTY COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING
OF INCANDESCENT AND FLUORESCENT LAMPS, FOR A
PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR
(\$14,000.00 - General Fund)

BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of Trustees of the Greater
Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Hough Supply & Specialty
Company received on the 29th day of March, 1982 for the furnishing
of incandescent and fluorescent lamps, for a period of one (1)
year, at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total expend-
iture not to exceed Fourteen Thousand & 00/100 (\$14,000.00) Dollars,
be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible
bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized
to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said
item.

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable out of the
General Fund.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an
obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor
to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action
Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding,
insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual
obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective
immediately upon its adoption.
