

RESOLUTION NO. 1982- 148

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH AMERICAN  
SCREEN PROCESS FOR THE FURNISHING OF BUS DESTINATION  
SIGNS, FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR  
(\$65,000.00 - General Fund)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater  
Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of American Screen Process received  
on the 7th day of April, 1982 for the furnishing of bus destination signs,  
at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure not to  
exceed Sixty-five Thousand & 00/100 (\$65,000.00) Dollars, be and the same  
is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General  
Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with  
said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable out of the  
General Fund.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obliga-  
tion of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid  
Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the  
Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and  
all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately  
upon its adoption.
