

RESOLUTION NO. 1982-156

FIXING THE RATES OF FARES TO BE
CHARGED ON THE GREATER CLEVELAND
REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That effective June 13, 1982, both the local and express fares for the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (GCRTA) shall each be increased by Twenty-Five Cents (\$.25). The weekly local pass and weekly express pass prices shall be based upon a multiple of ten (10) times the respective local and express fares. The monthly local pass and monthly express pass prices shall be based upon a multiple of forty (40) times the respective local and express single-ride fares. That an off-peak fare for senior citizens and handicapped persons shall be established at Twenty-Five Cents (\$.25).

That adult fare ticket purchases shall be discounted five cents (\$.05) below local and express cash fares. Existing tickets shall be honored after June 12, 1982 with the payment of \$.25, or they may be redeemed and/or exchanged at the GCRTA Customer Service Center.

Section 2. Effective September 1, 1982, discounts to students between the age of six (6) years and high school graduation age shall be discontinued.

Section 3. That the Rate of Fare to be charged on the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority are hereby fixed as follows:

CHILDREN'S FARES

One child under six (6) years of age may ride free when accompanied by a passenger paying an adult full fare.

MISCELLANEOUS FARES

Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Trustees, employees and Pensioners with I.D. cards, and all duly appointed, regular, full-time, Municipal and/or County police, fire, and law enforcement officers in uniform or upon showing their official badge and proper identification are permitted to ride free.

SUNDAY PASS

Sunday Pass: \$2.00

Valid for: Local, Express and Rail Transit Fares up to four (4) persons with a maximum of two (2) adults, 18 years of age or older.

Valid for: All regularly scheduled service on an unlimited basis as to frequency. Pass to be shown at each fare collection point.

That Weekly and Monthly passes, local and express, shall have Sunday Pass privileges as fares for a maximum of two (2) adults, eighteen (18) years of age or older.

FARES FOR RIDES OUTSIDE OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY

- (a) Rides wholly outside of Cuyahoga County \$1.00
- (b) Through rides between Downtown Cleveland and
 - Avon Lake (Lorain County) Route 31 1.60
 - Willowick (Lake County) Route 39 1.50
 - Willowick (Lake County) Route 43 1.50
 - Wickliffe (Lake County) Route 49 1.50
 - Brunswick (Medina County) Route 51 1.70
- (c) Rides wholly within Cuyahoga County on the above lines shall be:
 - (1) Local Cash Fare85
 - (2) Express Cash Fare 1.00
 - (3) Express Tickets
 - Five (5) for 4.75
 - (4) With Express Transfer No Charge
 - (5) Fare with weekly or monthly local pass, local fare ticket or transfer with connecting local lines, plus15
 - (6) With Monthly Express Pass No Charge

Section 4. That Resolutions 1975-84, adopted October 7, 1975; 1977-66, adopted February 22, 1977; 1979-134, adopted May 22, 1979; 1980-213, adopted June 3, 1980; 1981-217, adopted August 4, 1981; 1981-227 adopted August 18, 1981; 1981-254, adopted September 1, 1981; and 1981-305, adopted October 30, 1981, be and they are hereby rescinded effective May 30, 1982.

Section 5. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
