

RESOLUTION NO. 1982- 176

AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR ARCHITECT-ENGINEER SERVICES WITH TOGUCHI-OVINGTON ASSOCIATED ARCHITECTS FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$692,500 (Capital Grant OH-03-0054 - 80% UMTA and 20% Local Funding)

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority selected Toguchi-Ovington Associated Architects as the architect-engineer for Project 2A, Rapid Transit Station Rehabilitation Studies and Bridge Repairs, under Capital Grant OH-03-0054, by Resolution No. 1980-151, adopted April 15, 1980; and

WHEREAS, the contract with Toguchi-Ovington Associated Architects which has been negotiated in conformance with Resolution No. 1980-151, provides for the expenditure of funds in the amount of not to exceed \$692,500.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Toguchi-Ovington Associated Architects for architect-engineer services as will be required by Project 2A - Rapid Transit Station Rehabilitation Studies and Bridge Repairs of Capital Grant OH-03-0054.

Section 2. That said contract shall be consistent with the proposal submitted January 10, 1978, as modified by Resolution 1980-151.

Section 3. That the contract shall provide for the expenditure of funds not to exceed \$138,500 of GCRTA funds and \$554,000 of UMTA funds.


Section 4. That the funds for these architect-engineer services shall be allocated on an 80% federal-20% local basis as part of Capital Grant OH-03-0054 and shall be subject to the rules and regulations of UMTA.

Section 5. That the expenditure of not to exceed \$138,500 be and it is hereby authorized as the local matching share for these architect-engineer services.

Section 6. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Request for Proposal; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution No. 1981-273; insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 7. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
