

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SALES CONTRACT WITH CURTIS CALDWELL SALVAGE COMPANY (J.M. COUSINS COMPANY, INC.) FOR THE SALE OF NINE (9) NON-OPERABLE COACHES.
(\$2,700.00 - Capital Improvement Fund)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Curtis Caldwell Salvage Company (J.M. Cousins Company, Inc.) received on the 14th day of May, 1982, for the sale of nine (9) non-operable coaches, Nos. 605, 620, 633, 655, 687, 829, 1418, 1427 and 1649 at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total sales price not to exceed Two Thousand Seven Hundred & 00/100 (\$2,700.00) Dollars, be and same is hereby approved as the highest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder.

Section 2. That the monies received on said sales contract shall be deposited into the Capital Improvement Fund.

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
