

RESOLUTION NO. 1982- 219

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH BILDOC, INC. FOR PROJECT 11,
BID PACKAGE B, COMMUNITY RESPONSIVE TRANSIT FACILITY -
GENERAL CONSTRUCTION
(\$4,375,000 Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0054)

WHEREAS, the Bond submitted with the bid of Bildoc, Inc. was in proper form and was issued by an Ohio surety company and was compliant as a Bid Bond but requires additional financial resources as a performance bond; and

WHEREAS, Bildoc, Inc. will provide the necessary bonding prior to the execution of the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Bildoc, Inc. received on June 29, 1982, for Project 11, Bid Package B, Community Responsive Transit Facility - General Construction, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of not to exceed Four Million Three Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$4,375,000), be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with this bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, including a good and sufficient performance bond before execution of the contract, insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
