

RESOLUTION NO. 1982- 232

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH TEKTRONIX,
INC. FOR FURNISHING OF TWO (2) OSCILLOSCOPES.
(19,388.20 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0062)

WHEREAS the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority advertised for competitive bids for the furnishing of two (2) oscilloscopes; pursuant to Resolution No. 1979-263, adopted October 9, 1979 and

WHEREAS the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority received a single bid on July 1, 1981 from Textronix, Inc. for said items; and

WHEREAS, price analysis has been performed in accordance with applicable procedures for single bid situations; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority has found that the single bid price of Textronix, Inc. is fair and reasonable.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Textronix, Inc. received on the 1st day of July, 1981 for the furnishing of two (2) oscilloscopes, at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure not to exceed Nineteen Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-eight & 20/100 (\$19,388.20) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be subject to UMTA concurrence.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
