

RESOLUTION NO. 1982-273

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH THE HEGENSCHIEDT CORPORATION FOR THE FURNISHING OF MATERIALS AND SUPERVISORY LABOR TO MODIFY AND RELOCATE AN EXISTING HEGENSCHIEDT UNDERFLOOR WHEEL LATHE (\$64,035 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0054)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio :

Section 1. That it is hereby determined that the within services are non-competitive and cannot be secured from any source other than the Hegenscheidt Corporation.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Hegenscheidt Corporation for the furnishing of materials and supervisory labor to modify and relocate an existing Hegenscheidt underfloor wheel lathe, involving a total expenditure of not to exceed Sixty-Four Thousand and Thirty-Five Dollars (\$64,035).

Section 3. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon concurrence by UMTA.
