

RESOLUTION NO. 1982-276

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH YELLOW CAB COMPANY OF CLEVELAND INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF SPECIAL TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR THE COMMUNITY RESPONSIVE TRANSIT PROGRAM FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED THREE (3) YEARS.
(ANNUAL EXPENDITURE \$360,000.00 - General Fund)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the bid of Yellow Cab Company of Cleveland Inc. received on the 3rd day of September, 1982 for the furnishing of special transportation services for the Community Responsive Transit Program, for a period not to exceed three (3) years, at the price set forth in said bid, involving an annual expenditure not to exceed Three Hundred Sixty Thousand & 00/100 (\$360,000.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
