

RESOLUTION NO. 1982-277

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MOTOROLA, INC.
FOR THE FURNISHING OF TWO-WAY RADIOS AND RADIO COMMUNICATION
CONSOLE.

(\$3,076,709.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-05-0025)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Motorola, Inc. received on the 28th day
of June, 1982 for the furnishing of two-way radios and radio communication
console, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure
not to exceed Three Million Seventy-Six Thousand Seven Hundred Nine & 00/100
(\$3,076,709.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and
best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby
authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of
said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall be subject to UMTA concurrence.

Section 3. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of
80% UMTA funds.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obliga-
tion of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid
Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the
Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and
all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately
upon its adoption.
