

RESOLUTION NO. 1982-280

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH  
THE SPOHN CORPORATION FOR REPLACEMENT  
HEATERS AT BROOKLYN GARAGE (\$26,000.00 -  
GENERAL FUND)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland  
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of the Spohn Corporation received on  
August 27, 1982 for replacement heaters at Brooklyn Garage, at the prices  
set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of not to exceed  
twenty-six thousand & 00/100 (\$26,000.00) Dollars, be and the same is  
hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General  
Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract  
with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation  
of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid  
Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted  
by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance require-  
ments and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of  
the Authority.

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately  
upon its adoption.
