A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH DISPATCH INDUSTRIES FOR PROJECT 5, BID PACKAGE G1 CENTRAL RAIL MAINTENANCE FACILITY, FURNISH, DELIVER AND INSTALL SHOP EQUIPMENT ITEMS 3 AND 4 (\$52,979.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0062)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Dispatch Industries received on August 27, 1982 for Project 5, Bid Package G1, Central Rail Maintenance Facility, Furnish, Deliver, and Install Shop Equipment Items 3 and 4, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of not to exceed Fifty-two Thousand, Nine Hundred and Seventy-nine Dollars & 00/100 (\$52,979.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon concurrence by UMTA.
