

RESOLUTION NO. 1982-307

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH  
GARCO MACHINERY INC. FOR PROJECT 5 BID  
PACKAGE G1 CENTRAL RAIL MAINTENANCE  
FACILITY, FURNISH, DELIVER AND INSTALL SHOP  
EQUIPMENT ITEMS 2, 7 AND 29 (\$86,620.00 -  
Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0062)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland  
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Garco Machinery Inc. received on  
August 27, 1982 for Project 5, Bid Package G1, Central Rail Maintenance  
Facility, Furnish, Deliver and Install Shop Equipment Items 2, 7 and 29, at the  
prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of not to exceed  
Eighty-six Thousand, Six Hundred and Twenty Dollars & 00/100 (\$86,620.00)  
Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible  
bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into  
a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80%  
UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of  
the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification  
and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees  
in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws  
relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately  
upon concurrence by UMTA.
