

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH L.B.J., INC.
FOR THE REHABILITATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED
(100) STANDARD TRANSIT BUSES.
(\$5,200,000.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-05-0058)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of L.B.J., Inc., received on the 30th
day of August, 1982 for the rehabilitation of not to exceed one hundred
(100) standard transit buses, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving
a total expenditure not to exceed Five Million Two Hundred Thousand & 00/100
(\$5,200,000.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest
and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby
authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of
said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of
80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obliga-
tion of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid
Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the
Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and
all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately
upon its adoption.
