

RESOLUTION NO. 1983-33

PROVIDING FREE TRANSPORTATION ON ALL GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY ROUTES AND RAPID TRANSIT LINES TO ON-DUTY MEMBERS OF THE UNITED ALLIANCE OF GUARDIAN ANGELS, INC., DURING 1983.

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority receives requests for free fare privileges for representatives of agencies and organizations throughout the GCRTA service area; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority wishes to accommodate the needs of the representatives of such agencies and organizations when their services rendered are deemed to be desirable by and beneficial to the Authority and general public; and

WHEREAS, the request received from the Cleveland chapter of the Guardian Angels is consistent with the above-stated goal of the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:

Section 1. That members of the Guardian Angels be entitled to free travel throughout the RTA system when in performance of their assigned patrol duties.

Section 2. That such members shall be granted free travel only when in uniform, they present a special identification card to the appropriate RTA employee which bears their individual photograph.

Section 3. That the requisite uniform which will be recognized by the Authority for free fare shall consist of a red beret and a white "T-Shirt" imprinted with "Guardian Angels" in red letters.

Section 4. That presentation of the special identification card by a member not on duty or by someone other than whose picture appears on the card, constitutes a misuse of the free fare privileges which may jeopardize the continuation of those privileges.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
