

RESOLUTION NO. 1983-43

AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$11,800  
FOR EMPLOYEE INCENTIVE PROGRAMS DURING THE YEAR 1983  
FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL  
TRANSIT AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority has  
recognized a need to enhance employee development, employee performance,  
and to promote employee safety-consciousness; and

WHEREAS, five (5) programs have been developed for that purpose,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the  
Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That an expenditure of an amount not to exceed  
\$11,800 be and it is hereby authorized for the implementation of the  
five (5) programs listed below for 1983:

1.	PERFORMANCE AWARDS	\$7,000
2.	SERVICE RECOGNITION AWARDS	\$1,500
3.	DISTRICT AND SHOP SAFE PERFORMANCE AWARDS	\$ 300
4.	SAFETY COMMITTEE PROGRAM	\$1,500
5.	RETIREES' RECOGNITION NIGHT	<u>\$1,500</u>
	TOTAL	\$11,800

Section 2. That the expenditure of funds for each program shall  
be subject to review and approval by the General Manager and the  
Secretary-Treasurer.

Section 3. That this Resolution is effectively immediately upon  
its adoption.
