## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF OBSOLETE FAREBOXES AND FAREBOX MAGAZINES

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority has accumulated an inventory of obsolete and damaged beyond repair fareboxes and farebox magazines over the past few years; and

WHEREAS, this material was offered for sale utilizing competitive bidding procedures; and

WHEREAS, no bids were received for said material; and

WHEREAS, retaining these units in the Authority's inventory does not contribute to its efficient and effective operation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That these fareboxes and farebox magazines have no economical value to the Authority.

Section 2. That all obsolete and damaged beyond economic repair fareboxes and farebox magazines in the Authority's inventory be disposed of at the earliest practical date in the most cost-effective and efficient manner.

Section 3. That the provisions of Resolution 1980-412 shall remain operative for any farebox which is sold to an individual.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
