

RESOLUTION NO. 1983-86

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH LAKE ERIE MACHINERY COMPANY FOR PROJECT 4, BID PACKAGE E2-CENTRAL BUS MAINTENANCE FACILITY, SHOP EQUIPMENT (\$1,120,488.47 -Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0054)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Lake Erie Machinery Company received on February 9, 1983 for Project 4, Bid Package E2-Central Bus Maintenance Facility, Shop Equipment at the prices set forth in said bid involving a total expenditure of not to exceed one million, one hundred twenty thousand, four hundred eighty-eight and 47/100 (\$1,120,488.47) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
