

RESOLUTION NO. 1983- 107

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH  
BALL CHEMICAL COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING  
OF EIGHT (8) LITTER VACUUMS.  
(\$9,162.96 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0062)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland  
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Ball Chemical Company received on the  
8th day of December, 1982 for the furnishing of eight (8) litter vacuums,  
at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure not to  
exceed Nine Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Two & 96/100 (\$9,162.96) Dollars, be  
and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and  
the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a  
contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80%  
UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of  
the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification  
and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees  
in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws  
relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective upon concurrence  
from UMTA.
