

RESOLUTION NO. 1983-183

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MACHINERY INSTALLERS AND ALIGNERS FOR THE MOVING OF THE HEGENSCHIEDT UNDERFLOOR WHEEL LATHE TO THE NEW RAIL MAINTENANCE FACILITY.
(\$35,852.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0054)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Machinery Installers & Aligners received on the 10th day of May, 1983 for moving the Hegenscheidt underfloor wheel lathe to the new rail maintenance facility, at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of Thirty-five Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-two & 00/100 (\$35,852.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
