

RESOLUTION NO. 1983-196

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH BETHLEHEM  
STEEL CORPORATION FOR PROJECT 23, BID PACKAGE B,  
FURNISHING OF RAIL AND RESTRAINING RAIL, ITEM 1  
(\$306,900.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-09-0001)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the bid of Bethlehem Steel Corporation received on July 15, 1983 for Project 23, Bid Package B, Furnishing of Rail and Restraining Rail, Item 1, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of not to exceed Three Hundred Six Thousand, Nine Hundred & 00/100 (\$306,900.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
