

RESOLUTION NO. 1983- 197

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH L. B. FOSTER COMPANY FOR PROJECT 23, BID PACKAGE B, FURNISHING OF RAIL AND RESTRAINING RAIL, ITEMS 2 THROUGH 7
(\$700,228 - Capital Improvement Fund - OH-09-0001)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of L. B. Foster Company received on July 15, 1983, for Project 23, Bid Package B, Furnishing of Rail and Restraining Rail, Items 2 through 7, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of not to exceed Seven Hundred Thousand, Two Hundred Twenty-Eight and 00/100 (\$700,228.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective upon concurrence by UMTA.
