

RESOLUTION NO. 1983-221

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH
IRD MECHANALYSIS FOR PROJECT 5, BID
PACKAGE G1B-CENTRAL RAIL MAINTENANCE
FACILITY-SHOP EQUIPMENT (Item 2)
(\$31,355.00-Capital Improvement Fund OH-
03-0062)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of IRD Mechanalysis received on June 7, 1983
for Project 5, Bid Package G1B-Central Rail Maintenance Facility-Shop Equipment
(Item 2), at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of
not to exceed thirty-one thousand, three hundred fifty-five and 00/100
(\$31,355.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best
responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized
to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80%
UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of
the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid
Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the
Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and
all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately
upon concurrence by UMTA.
