

RESOLUTION NO. 1983- 222

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH
PENTA CONSTRUCTION CORP./EUGENE GOLDMAN,
INC. FOR PROJECT 23, BID PACKAGE A-
REHABILITATION OF RED LINE TRACK
(\$3,254,000-Capital Improvement Fund OH-
90-0001 and \$357,000-Capital Improvement
Fund OH-03-0054)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Penta Construction Corp./Eugene Goldman,
Inc. received on August 23, 1983 for Project 23, Bid Package A-Rehabilitation
of Red Line Track, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total
expenditure of not to exceed three million, six hundred eleven thousand and
00/100 (\$3,611,000.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the
lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is
hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing
of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80%
UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of
the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid
Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the
Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and
all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately
upon its adoption.
