

RESOLUTION NO. 1983- 223

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND  
AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MIDLAND  
HARDWARE COMPANY FOR DOOR REPAIRS AT  
CLEVELAND UNION TERMINAL AT A COST NOT  
TO EXCEED \$5,800 (\$5,800 - General Fund)

WHEREAS, the doors to the Light Rail Platform at Cleveland Union Terminal have deteriorated severely;

WHEREAS, such deterioration constitutes a real and present emergency to the Authority because of the actual physical damage to the doors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the accelerated deterioration of the doors to the Light Rail Platform at the Cleveland Union Terminal constitutes a real and present danger to the Authority.

Section 2. That the proposal of Midland Hardware Company received on August 19, 1983, for door repairs at Cleveland Union Terminal, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of not to exceed Fifty-Eight Hundred and 00/100 (\$5,800.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as a fair and reasonable price for the goods and services offered, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution No. 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
