## RESOLUTION 1983-233

AUTHORIZING THE SOLICITATION OF PROPOSALS FOR ARCHITECT/ENGINEER SERVICES FOR VARIOUS PROJECTS FUNDED BY THE URBAN MASS TRANSPORTATION ADMINISTRATION

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority has included in its Transportation Improvement Program the following Capital Improvement projects:

Project No. 17 - Rehabilitation of Four Bus Garages

Project No. 18 - Rehabilitation of Seventeen Bus Loops

Project No. 19 - Rehabilitation of Two Rail Maintenance Shops

Project No. 22 - New District Bus Garage

Project No. 23 - Rehabilitation of Red Line Track and Structures

Project No. 24 - Rehabilitation of Red Line Stations

and

WHEREAS, The Urban Mass Transportation Administration has funded or is expected to fund between 75% and 85% of the costs of these projects through Grants OH-O3-O062, OH-O5-O025, OH-90-O01, and other future grants; and

WHEREAS, Architectural and Engineering services are required in order to carry out these projects; and

WHEREAS, the cost of such services is an eligible expense under the UMTA grant program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Director of Procurement be and is hereby authorized and directed to transmit requests for proposals to provide architectural and engineering services, on a personal service basis, as required to carry out the above mentioned projects, in accordance with the Procurement Policy of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority.

Section 2. That no contract for the provision of such architectural and engineering services shall be executed until the Board of Trustees, by separate resolution, shall award such contract in accordance with the Procurement Policy of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
