

RESOLUTION NO. 1983-300

DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING
AN EXPEDITED PROCESS FOR REPAIRS TO A
RETAINING WALL AT THE GREATER CLEVELAND
REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY BROOKLYN
GARAGE

WHEREAS, the Authority owns an operating garage at 4371 Pearl Road; and

WHEREAS, a portion of a retaining wall at this location and adjacent to the convent of Our Lady of Good Counsel Church collapsed on Friday, May 25, 1979 and since then temporary measures have been taken to insure the stability of the remaining wall; and

WHEREAS, the deterioration of the remaining wall appears to be accelerating and immediate repairs are necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland has directed the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority to make repairs to this wall within the next 30 days;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Board of Trustees hereby determines that a real and present danger exists due to actual physical damage to the retaining wall located along the southerly boundary of the Authority's Brooklyn Garage.

Section 2. That the Director of Construction Management and Engineering be and he is hereby authorized and directed to select the best available contractor and commence negotiations for repairs to the above mentioned retaining wall. Time being of the essence, an expedited process is expressly authorized.

Section 3. That the cost of this work shall not exceed \$20,000.

Section 4. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon adoption.
