A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH UNION SWITCH AND SIGNAL DIVISION, AMERICAN STANDARD, INC. FOR PROJECT 12A, BID PACKAGE A-IMPROVEMENTS TO OPERATIONS CONTROL CENTER & TRAIN CONTROL SYSTEM: CAB SIGNALLING - WEST PARK TO CUT (\$6,878,000.00 - CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0062 80% UMTA FUNDING AND 20% LOCAL FUNDING)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Union Switch and Signal Division, American Standard, Inc. received on January 17, 1984 for Project 12A, Bid Package A-Improvements to Operations Control Center & Train Control System: Cab Signalling - West Park to CUT, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of not to exceed six million, eight hundred seventy-eight thousand and 00/100 (\$6,878,000.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
