A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE GIBSON-STEWART COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF ONE (1) HYDRAULIC IMPACT HAMMER AND 24" BUCKET.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the bid of The Gibson-Stewart Company received on the 18th day of November, 1983 for the furnishing of one (1) hydraulic impact hammer and 24" bucket, at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of Ten Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-one & 00/100 (\$10,561.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and UMTA concurrence.
