

RESOLUTION NO. 1984-57

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH BALL CHEMICAL COMPANY  
FOR THE FURNISHING OF TEN (10) WET/DRY VACUUM CLEANERS.  
(\$7,063.50 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0062)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland  
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the bid of Ball Chemical Company received on the  
30th day of September, 1983 for the furnishing of ten (10) wet/dry vacuum  
cleaners, at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure  
of Seven Thousand Sixty-three & 50/100 (\$7,063.50) Dollars, be and the same  
is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General  
Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with  
said bidder for the furnishing of said item.


Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of  
80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obliga-  
tion of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid  
Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the  
Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and  
all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately  
upon its adoption and UMTA concurrence.
