

RESOLUTION 1984-71

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH
KIDDE AUTOMATED SYSTEMS, INC. FOR THE
FURNISHING, MODIFICATION AND INSTALLATION
OF AUTOMATIC DOOR LOCKING AND SECURITY
SYSTEM AND ASSOCIATED HARDWARE AT CENTRAL
BUS MAINTENANCE FACILITY
(\$12,685.00 - General Fund)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That it is hereby determined that the within commodity
is non-competitive and cannot be secured from any source other than Kidde
Automated Systems, Inc.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority is hereby
authorized to enter into a contract with Kidde Automated Systems, Inc.,
its successors or assigns for the furnishing, modification, and installa-
tion of automatic door locking and security system and associated hardware,
involving an estimated expenditure of Twelve Thousand, Six Hundred Eighty-
Five and 00/100 (\$12,685.00) Dollars.

Section 3. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure
from the General Fund.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an
obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor
to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan
adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance
requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations
of the Authority.
