A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH KARG DODGE INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF SIXTEEN (16) FRONT WHEEL DRIVE PASSENGER AUTOMOBILES. (\$103,953.48 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-05-0065) (\$ 34,217.83 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0062)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Karg Dodge Inc., received on the 18th day of April, 1984 for the furnishing of sixteen (16) front wheel drive passenger automobiles, at the price set forth in said bid, including trade-ins, involving a total expenditure not to exceed One Hundred Thirty-eight Thousand One Hundred Seventy-one & 31/100 (\$138,171.31) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.
