## RESOLUTION NO. 1984-135

DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH GARFIELD HEIGHTS COACH LINES, INC. FOR THE REPAIR OF APPROXIMATELY 30 SERIES 2500 COACHES FOR AN EXPENDITURE NOT TO EXCEED \$450,000.00.

WHEREAS, the 2500 series G.M.C. coaches has been extensively used in line service and has approximately 375,000 miles per coach; and

WHEREAS, the frames of these coaches require immediate repairs; and

WHEREAS, the number of coaches requiring repairs exceed in volume the number which can be handled by Authority repair facilities; and

WHEREAS, the service requirements of the Authority make it imperative that these coaches be returned to service as soon as possible; and

WHEREAS, Garfield Heights Coach Lines, Inc. possess the facilities and experience to make those repairs; and

WHEREAS, the Garfield Heights Coach Lines, Inc. is no longer in the mass transit service and has the present capacity to make the repairs; and

WHEREAS, Garfield Heights Coach Lines, Inc. has submitted a quote of \$14,892.26 per coach to perform the repairs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That by virtue of the volume of repairs and the necessity to return these coaches to service, a real and present emergency exists.

Section 2. That due to the existing emergency the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into an emergency contract with Garfield Heights Coach Lines, Inc. for vehicle repairs at an expenditure not to exceed Four Hundred Fifty Thousand & 00/100 (\$450,000.00) Dollars, payable out of the General Fund.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
