

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH CLEVELAND TRUCK CENTER GENERAL MOTORS CORP. TRUCK AND BUS GROUP FOR THE FURNISHING OF TWO (2) BUS MOBILE REPAIR TRUCKS.
(\$109,597.50 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-05-0065)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the bid of Cleveland Truck Center General Motors Corp. Truck and Bus Group received on the 7th day of March, 1984, for the furnishing of two (2) bus mobile repair trucks, at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of One Hundred Nine Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-Seven & 50/100 (\$109,597.50) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
