RESOLUTION NO. 1985 - 49

> A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR PARKING MANAGEMENT SERVICES RELATED TO THE RAIL TRANSIT PARKING FACILITIES

WHEREAS, it is desirable to increase the sense of security in and improve the maintenance of the rail transit parking facilities; and

WHEREAS, it is advisable to test the concept of paid secure supervised parking on a limited basis to ensure public acceptance and to develop the concept fully; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that professional parking management services are necessary to adequately test the public's acceptance of paying a modest parking fee in exchange for secure supervised parking and to assist in the design of an overall rail transit parking concept.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Department of Procurement be and is hereby authorized to advertise a Request for Proposals for parking management services related to a one-year pilot project at two rapid transit stations with an option to expand the concept system-wide in up to 5 years.

<u>Section 2.</u> That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
