

RESOLUTION NO. 1985- 70

EXTENDING SENIOR CITIZENS' FARE PRIVILEGES ON
"SENIOR CITIZENS' DAY", MAY 21, 1985

WHEREAS, Tuesday, May 21, 1985, will be recognized throughout the state as "Ohio Senior Citizens Day"; and

WHEREAS, there will be special programs honoring the Senior Citizens on that day; and

WHEREAS, some of these programs may extend beyond the usual RTA Elderly Fare hours; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees wishes to recognize "Ohio Senior Citizens' Day" as the one day annually that it shall extend this privilege;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:

Section 1. That between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 21, 1985, the reduced 25-cents transit fare shall be extended to all Senior Citizens properly registered with the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority for the reduced Elderly Fare.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
